Most of the information is already known and can be found on the internet. Thought the book would contain a list of available scholarship sites. This is not the case. It is a workbook for the high school student/parents which provides an ongoing plan for beginning the search for scholarship/financial aid. Opening chapters recall the author's background/early childhood and the obstacles she overcame in order to reach her goal (to be debt free after graduation from university). If you are looking for direct information concerning resources, names and addresses of foundations, etc., you will not find it here. Most helpful are her hints and suggestions for developing good study and organizational skills. The most encouraging aspect of this book is the advice given by an accomplished graduate student to a beginning high school student and his/her parents.
