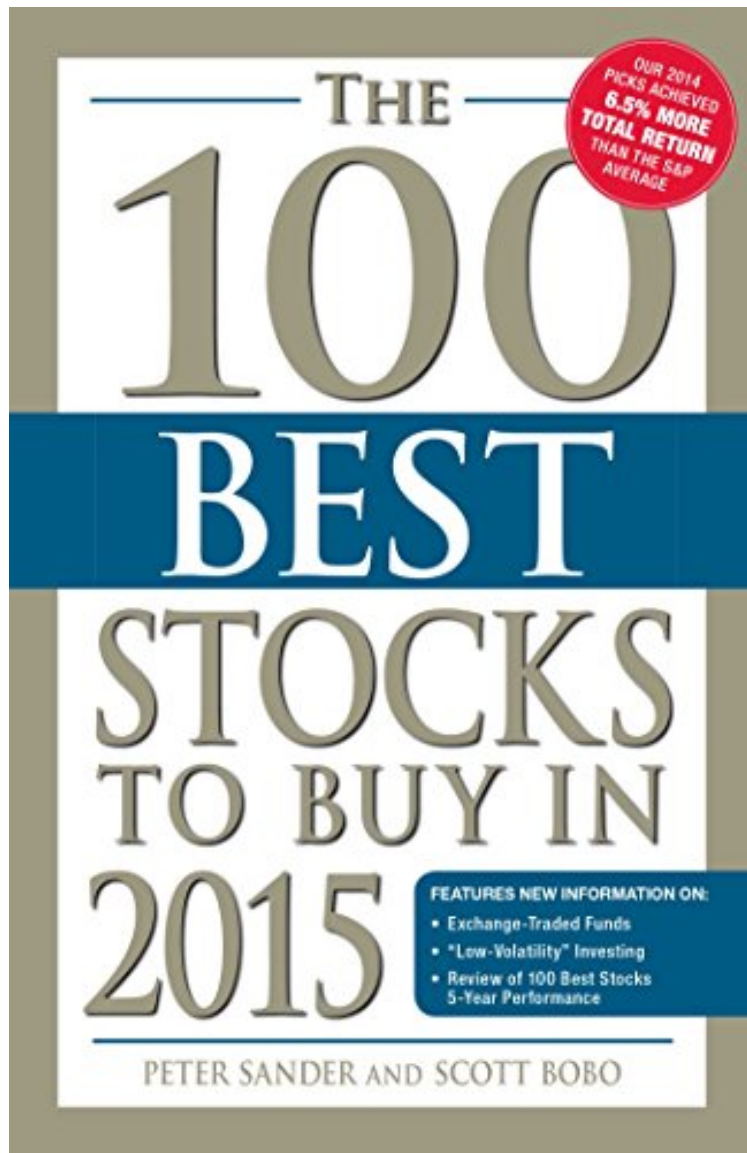

It gives a synopsis of each company and what is attractive about investing in it and reasons for caution. The reason I chose this book and continue to reorder it, is that I am interested in the types of companies profiled in their 100 Best Stock lists and their investing style of holding their picks for longer periods of time rather than trading them. For this reason, only a handful (between 10 and 15) of the stocks change from year to year. Another plus is that they have the courage of their conviction and review the performance of their previous year's stock picks; something not seen too often in other books of this type.
